

# MONDAY MORNING PAINTERS SCHEDULE

Mondays, from 9:00 am-1:00 pm, critique at 12:30.

## AUGUST 4

Petaluma marshes near Sheraton Hotel  
745 Baywood Dr. Water & bridge, boats, overpass views. Small peninsula on west side. From southbound 101: Take Lakeville Hwy/116 exit. Turn right at 3rd light onto Baywood. Park in front near coffeehouse, park legally & walk to western side of buildings, or check out east side walk. Critique 12:30 on western side at bench.

## AUGUST 11

Cloverdale River Ranch Park, Cloverdale  
31820 McCray Rd, take last Cloverdale exit "Boonville Hwy 128" but turn right on N. Cloverdale Blvd, right on McCray. River & hill views. Regional park fee applies. Restroom.

## AUGUST 18

Rose & Thorn Co., Sebastopol  
10050 Bodega Hwy opens at 11AM, Carol will let us in gate from 9-9:15, if late, come when they open at 11. Nice & varied grounds, w/goats, chickens, up close garden & sculpture views, some shady nooks.

## AUGUST 25

South Salmon Creek, Bodega Bay  
From Bodega Bay go north on Hwy 1 to South Salmon Creek turnoff. Park in free parking lot, don't park on the narrow street. Ocean, creek, dunes, summer cottages, "restroom."  
12:30 Critique in parking lot.

## SEPTEMBER 1

Roberts Lake, Rohnert Park  
5000 Roberts Lake Rd. 101 to Golf Course Dr to Roberts Lake Road north of Commerce Blvd. Hey, there's water n' reflections, geese, some hill vistas AND it's close by; save gas, paint local.

## SEPTEMBER 8

Armstrong Redwoods, Guerneville  
Cool, shady groves, Bull Frog Pond Rd closed due to State deficit, state park fee. Critique at group picnic area at base of Bull Frog Rd 12:30.

## SEPTEMBER 15

Juilliard Park, Santa Rosa  
Across the street from Luther Burbank Gardens... 531 Juilliard Park Dr, from downtown Santa Rosa, take Santa Rosa Ave, right on Sonoma Ave, left on S. A St, suggest parking back on S. A St. We've been unable to get permission to paint at Luther Burbank with such a large group. However, Juilliard is big and shady, & there is also a shallow city park that runs along Sonoma Ave, north of Luther Burbank, but metered parking only there. Juilliard has nice focal points and views into Luther Burbank...we can spread out around here. Pay attention to parking hour limits, city will GET ya. 12:30 Critique near center of Juilliard park structure.

## SEPTEMBER 22

Memorial Beach  
Healdsburg 13839 Old Redwood Highway, from northbound 101, take first Healdsburg exit. Need regional parking permit or pay \$5 for main lot. Some parking over bridge, turn right, along Front St, nearer tracks & shade trees. Russian River, historic bridges, railroad tracks, canoes and figure painting swimmers, all possibilities.

## SEPTEMBER 29

Spud Point, Bodega Bay  
North on Hwy 1, through town of Bodega Bay take Eastshore Road, go downhill to stop sign and turn right, traveling around the bay. Park in the Spud Point Marina lot. Critique at the picnic table south of the Marina office. Boats, hills, and water.  
Restrooms at Marina office, deli.

## OCTOBER 6

Paradise Ridge Winery  
Vista views of Santa Rosa, vineyards, hills, oaks. From n/b Hwy. 101, take the Bicentennial exit and go east, past two stoplights and around a hill, where the road merges with Fountaingrove Parkway. Take the second left onto Thomas Lake Harris Drive and go 0.7 miles to the winery gate on the left. Follow the road through the Sculpture Park and park in the upper tasting room lot. Critique in stone-walled path adjacent to upper parking lot.

## OCTOBER 13

Duncan's Landing  
If you drive north on Highway One, it's 5.5 miles north of Bodega Bay's Candy & Kites. Turn left at the Duncan's landing sign. Crashing waves, rocks n' shrubbery, coastal vistas, sheltered cove. No fee. Bathrooms near entrance torn down, porta potty probably now.

## OCTOBER 20

Pedroncelli Winery  
1220 Canyon Rd., Geyserville [www.pedroncelli.com](http://www.pedroncelli.com), Bocce Ball court above, can park along vines beside the road. Nice if you can purchase something while there.  
Take Hwy. 101 N to Geyserville, exit at Canyon Rd., go west up beautiful Canyon Rd. about a mile to the winery on the right. Rolling hills, lush vines in a lovely old winery setting. Critique in patio area outside tasting room.

## OCTOBER 27

Gundlach Bundschu Winery  
2000 Denmark St, Sonoma. Heart of the wine country vistas, great winery. Hwy 12 east to the plaza, turn right onto E Napa St. Right on 8th St East. At the Gundlach Bundschu sign, turn left onto Denmark St. & follow it around to the gates of our winery. Special Instructions: Park in lower gravel lot on left ONLY. Do not drive into vineyards nor park along entry road. On hill above 17 vineyards which may be in autumn color splendor, lake, gardens, trails. 12:30 Critique - picnic tables at restrooms.
