January 1, 2007

Spud Point

North on Hwy 1, through town of Bodega Bay take Eastshore Road, go downhill to stop sign and turn right, traveling around the bay. Park in the Spud Point Marina lot. Critique at the picnic table south of the Marina office. Boats, hills, and water. Restrooms at Marina office, deli food at store.

January 8, 2007

Shollenberger Park

From 101, exit at Highway 116 East, go east 0.8 miles. Turn on South McDowell Ave. Take 3rd right on City Park Street & park in the lot. Wetlands, birds, reeds, cat tails, vista across freeway to hill. Restrooms. The City Park sign is very small and looks like a road identification sign There is no street called "City Park".

January 15, 2007

Laguna Wetland Preserve

From Hwy 12 toward Sebastopol turn right on Morris St. Drive two blocks, park at Community Center or there is parking on Occidental Road just past the bridge. There is a deep shoulder, so enter and exit parking slowly. There is also minimum parking north on Sanford Road.

January 22, 2007

Rancho Olompali State Historical Park

Redwood Highway, Marin County. Take 101 south to the Olompali access road, 4.7 miles past the Petaluma Blvd. South exit. Old adobe rancho, barns, vista of river plain, bathroom fee \$2. Parking fee: \$5. Critique by adobe ruin/ picnic tables.

January 29, 2007

Walker Creek

From downtown Tomales, go south one mile towards Tomales Bay. Park in turnout to left of Walker Creek Bridge. Great view of creek winding down through the valley.

February 5, 2007

Healdsburg Plaza

Downtown Healdsburg. Trees, interesting buildings, people, shops, art galleries and restaurants.

February 12, 2007

Town of Freestone

From Sebastopol go west on Bodega Hwy. Turn right at Bohemian Hwy into the little town. View of hills and country town.

February 19, 2007

Ledson Winery

335 Highway 12, Kenwood. From 101, take Hwy 12 exit towards Sonoma (east). Views of the castle, surrounding hills & vineyards. Restrooms and shade.

February 26, 2007

South Salmon Creek

On Highway 1 from Bodega Bay, go north to South Salmon Creek turnoff. Proceed to the free parking area. Don't park on the narrow street. Ocean, creek, dunes summer cottages. Restrooms. Critique in the parking lot.

March 5, 2007

Kozlowski Farms

5566 Gravenstein Hwy (116), Forestville. Located between Graton and Forestville, watch for the signs on the west side of Hwy. Charming farmhouse, outbuildings, valley views. Don't park in front of the store.

March 12, 2007

Armstrong Woods

Guerneville. Take River Road (Hwy 116) to downtown Guerneville. Turn north onto Armstrong Road at the stoplight. Drive into the park and up to Bullfrog Pond for great vistas or water views. Parking fee.

March 19, 2007

Petaluma Turning Basin

From Hwy 101, take East Washington exit west and turn left on Petaluma Blvd. Turn on B Street and go to the end, turning right into the Great Petaluma Mill parking lot. Views of river, mill, yacht club, boats. Critique along Weller Street.

March 26, 2007

Warneke Sonoma Vineyards

13427 Chalk Hill Road, Healdsburg. Private; views of vineyards, house and garden, rolling hills, Russian River, ponds.

Change to morning schedule (9:00 am -1:00 pm, critique at 12:30 pm)

April 2, 2007

Luther Burbank Gardens

Santa Rosa. Corner of Santa Rosa and Sonoma Avenues.

April 9, 2007

Sonoma Plaza, Sonoma

Sonoma Plaza, Sonoma. Trees, interesting buildings, people, shops, art galleries and restaurants.

April 16, 2007

Vineyard Club in Geyserville

355 Rockmound Road, Geyserville. Directions from Website: From Highway 101 take Highway 128 exit and head east. In town of Geyserville (don't blink, you'll miss it), take a right at the only stop sign in town. Follow Highway 128 over the Russian River until you come to the intersection of River Road and Hwy 128 (the Geyserville Oriental Community Center provides a good landmark). Take a hard left onto River Road and follow it for about three miles. You will see a sign at the bottom of a windy hill that says "Welcome to the Vineyard." Follow the windy road up the hill and into our community (the name of the road changes to Vineyard Road but you stay on the same road). Private lake and view of hills, olive orchards, vineyards.

April 23, 2007

Shone Farms

6225 Eastside Road, Forestville. From Hwy 101, take River Road and head west. Go approximately 6 miles and turn onto Trenton-Healdsburg Road, drive approximately 1.5 miles to Eastside Road, turn left onto Eastside Road and make an immediate right into the Shone Farm entrance. Restrooms.

April 30, 2007

Girard Winery

1551 Sage Canyon Road, St. Helena. Beautiful setting with large pond, vistas & vineyards.
