## **Benziger Family Winery**

1883 London Ranch Rd, Glen Ellen. Vineyards, oak trees, peacocks; ample parking, restrooms.

July 16, 2007

## **Healdsburg Veterans Memorial Beach**

13839 Old Redwood Highway, Healdsburg. There is shade and restrooms, views of bridges and river or park and buildings. \$6 parking fee. Critique in the park.

July 23, 2007

## **South Salmon Creek**

(Rained out last time)

From Bodega Bay go north on Hwy 1 to South Salmon Creek turnoff. Park in free parking lot, don't park on the narrow street. Ocean, creek, dunes, summer cottages, restroom. Bring your own shade. Critique in parking lot.

July 30, 2007

## **Goat Rock**

Low and high views of coast with waves, rocks, cliffs. From town of Bodega Bay go about 8 miles north on Hwy. 1 and turn left at the Goat Rock sign. If the access road is open all the way to the beach at the bottom, take the left fork and park in the beach lot at the very end of the road on the left. Critique will be there, too.

August 6, 2007

## **Trentadue Winery**

19170 Geyserville Ave., Geyserville. From Hwy 101, take Independence Lane exit, left to Geyserville Ave. Vineyards, buildings, hills. Critique under arbor in front of tasting room.

August 13, 2007

## **Town of Cazadero**

Quaint town in the redwood trees. Meet at General Store for critique.

August 20, 2007

## **Victorian Homes in Petaluma**

From Hwy 101, take the Washington Exit and go west; downtown to Keller Street, then 2 blocks to 5th Street. The 1860 era stately Victorian District is on 5th and 6th Streets bounded by A and D Streets.

August 27, 2007

## **Mazzocco Winery**

1400 Lytton Springs Road, Healdsburg. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Do not park in tasting room parking lot; drive past tasting room to park in gravel area near barn.

September 3, 2007

## **Old Penngrove**

Located between Petaluma and Cotati. Interesting buildings and views.

September 10, 2007

## **Dutcher Crossing Winery**

8333 Dry Creek Rd, Healdsburg. Rolling hills planted in vineyards.

September 17, 2007

## **Lake Ralphine/Howarth Park**

650 Summerfield Rd., Santa Rosa. Shady trees, picnic tables, lake with boats and waterfowl.

September 24, 2007

## **School House Beach**

At Carmet on Hwy 1, 8 to 9 miles north of Hwy 12.

October 1, 2007

## **Robert Young Winery**

4960 Red Winery Road, Healdsburg. Fantastic view of Alexander Valley from the top of knoll. To paint from knoll, drive past tasting room, turn left through gate and follow unpaved road to top of hill. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Do not park in visitor parking lot.

October 8, 2007

## **Town of Tomales**

Quaint buildings, vistas. Located on Hwy 1 in Marin County, about 7 miles south of Valley Ford, or 18 miles west of Petaluma. Critique at general store on Shoreline Hwy.

October 15, 2007

## **Shiloh Ranch Regional Park**

5750 Faught Road, Santa Rosa. Wooded area, vistas of hills and vineyards; fee parking, but free parking available across street.

October 22, 2007

## **Adobe Pumpkin Patch**

2478 East Washington Street, Petaluma. Gates open at 9:00 am. Rain cancels venue because of adobe mud.

October 29, 2007

## **Valley Ford**

Victorians, funky buildings, hillsides. Meet at Dinucci's Restaurant for critique.
