**September 25, 2006**

## **Paradise Ridge Winery**

Vista views of Santa Rosa, vineyards, hills, oaks. From Hwy. 101, take the Bicentennial exit and go east, past two stoplights and around a hill, where the road merges with Fountaingrove Parkway. Take the second left onto Thomas Lake Harris Drive and go 0.7 miles to the winery gate on the left. Follow the road through the sculpture park and park in the upper tasting room lot. Critique in stone-walled path adjacent to upper parking lot.

**October 2, 2006**

## **Town of Tomales**

Quaint buildings, vistas. Located on Hwy 1 in Marin County, about 7 miles south of Valley Ford, or 18 miles west of Petaluma. Meet at the general store on Shoreline Hwy for critique.

**October 9, 2006**

## **Belvedere Winery**

Vineyards, vistas, tasting room, gardens. 4035 Westside Road. We have been asked to please park in the back lot.

**October 16, 2006**

## **Marshall Boat Works**

Working docks, restaurant, boats, bay and hill views. West Marin County on Hwy 1, 11 miles west of Petaluma on Marshall-Petaluma Rd. Park out of the way of the boat business.

**October 23, 2006**

## **Rio Lindo Academy**

From Santa Rosa, go north on Hwy 101 to the first Healdsburg exit and turn right. Drive for 0.5 miles; turn right on Bailache Avenue at the Academy sign. Go up hill 3.4 miles to the stop sign at the school entrance. Turn left and park just past the church. Unusual view of Russian River valley, farms, vineyards.

**October 30, 2006**

## **Town of Geyserville**

From Santa Rosa, take Hwy 101 north to Geyserville Exit. Vineyards, old buildings, hill views. Critique by the Geyser Smokehouse.

**November 6, 2006**

## **Viansa Winery, 25200 Arnold Drive, Sonoma**

Take Hwy 116 East towards Sonoma. Continue south on Hwy 116 (where Hwy 116 becomes Arnold Drive), past Fremont Drive (where Hwy 116 becomes Hwy 121). Spectacular Italian villa, store, old vines and view of bird sanctuary. A little bit of Tuscany.

**November 13, 2006**

## **Bloomfield**

On Bloomfield Road, 0.25 miles north of Valley Ford Road. Farms, cow, vistas. Critique by the old town hall/Masonic Lodge building.

**November 20, 2006**

## **Glen Ellen**

From Santa Rosa take Hwy 12 east to sign for Glen Ellen at Arnold Drive. Turn right, and go 0.8 miles, over the creek to the town center. Critique by the old stone building.

**November 27, 2006**

## **Riverfront Regional Park**

7821 Eastside Road, Healdsburg. From Santa Rosa take 101 north, then take Central Windsor exit. Turn left onto Old Redwood Hwy. Stay straight and turn left where road divides, go onto Windsor River Rd. until it dead-ends. Turn left onto Eastside Road for 1.9 miles. Regional Parking fee: \$5.

**Change to afternoon schedule (12-4, critique at 3:30)**

**December 4, 2006**

## **Spring Lake**

Lake, trees, and hill views. Hwy 12 east to Hoen, cross Summerfield Road, left at Spring Lake sign on Newanga, continue to park. Parking fee: \$5.

**December 11, 2006**

## **Crane Creek Regional Park**

Views of hills, Santa Rosa plain, vineyards, buildings. From downtown Cotati, take East Cotati Avenue past Sonoma State University. Turn right on Petaluma Hill Road, go 0.5 mile then turn left on Roberts Road. Drive 1.8 miles to parking lot on the left. Parking fee: \$5

**December 18, 2006**

## **Madrona Manor**

Old Victorian buildings, gardens. 1001 Westside Road, Healdsburg.

**December 25, 2006 - No Schedule**

**January 1, 2007**

## **Spud Point**

Boats, hills, and water. Rest rooms at Marina office, deli food at store. North on Hwy 1, through town of Bodega Bay take Eastshore Road, go downhill to stop sign and turn right, traveling around the bay. Park in the Spud Point Marina lot. Critique at the picnic table south of the Marina office.

**January 8, 2007**

## **Shollenberger Park**

Great Petaluma Mill parking lot. River, mill, yacht club, boats. From Hwy 101, take East Washington exit west and turn left on Petaluma Blvd., turn left on B Street and go to the end, turning right into the Critique in Great Petaluma Mill parking lot.

**January 15, 2007**

## **Laguna Wetland Preserve**

From Hwy 12 toward Sebastopol turn right on Morris St. Drive two blocks, park at Community Center or there is parking on Occidental Road just past the bridge. There is a deep shoulder, so enter and exit parking slowly. There is also minimum parking north on Sanford Road.

**January 22, 2007**

## **Rancho Olompali State Historical Park**

Old adobe rancho, barns, vista of river plain; bathroom fee \$2. Redwood Highway, Marin County. Take 101 south to the Olompali access road, 4.7 miles past the Petaluma Blvd. South exit. Critique by adobe ruin/ picnic tables. Parking fee: \$5.

**January 29, 2007**

## **Walker Creek**

Great view of creek winding down through the valley. Downtown Tomales, go south one mile towards Tomales Bay. Park in turnout to left of Walker Creek Bridge.
