September 24, 2007

School House Beach

At Carmet on Hwy 1, 8 to 9 miles north of Hwy 12.

October 1, 2007

Robert Young Winery

4960 Red Winery Road, Healdsburg.

Fantastic view of Alexander Valley from the top of knoll. To paint from knoll, drive past tasting room, turn left through gate and follow unpaved road to top of hill. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Do not park in visitor parking lot.

October 8, 2007

Town of Tomales

Quaint buildings, vistas. Located on Hwy 1 in Marin County, about 7 miles south of Valley Ford, or 18 miles west of Petaluma. Critique at general store on Shoreline Hwy.

October 15, 2007

Shiloh Ranch Regional Park

5750 Faught Road, Santa Rosa.

Wooded area, vistas of hills and vineyards; fee parking, but free parking available across street.

October 22, 2007

Adobe Pumpkin Patch

2478 East Washington Street, Petaluma. Gates open at 9:00 am. Rain cancels venue because of adobe mud.

October 29, 2007

Valley Ford

Victorians, funky buildings, hillsides. Meet at Dinucci's Restaurant for critique.

November 5

Bird Walk Regional Park

355 Hwy 1, Bodega Bay Views of restored Salt Marsh, Bodega Head, elevated flat walk/loop; on left just before town after Doran Park turnoff. Porta Potty. Regional parking fee box \$5. Critique in parking lot.

November 12

Sonoma Valley Regional Park

13630 Sonoma Hwy. 12, Glen Ellen 167 acres, oak woodlands, views of Mt Hood & other hills. Restroom. Parking fee \$5.

November 19

Kendall Jackson Wine Center

5007 Fulton Rd., Fulton from north bound 101, exit River Road, turn left, right on Fulton Rd. 2+ acres of culinary gardens, vineyards. Park in the first lot.

November 26

Sonoma Horticultural Nursery

3970 Azalea Ave, Sebastopol. 8 acres of demonstration nursery. Take Hwy 116 south of Sebastopol, to Hessel Rd, right on McFarlane, right on Azalea. Opens at 9am. Limited parking/carpool suggested, \$3 donation each.

Schedule changes to afternoon 12-4 pm, critique at 3:30

December 3

South Salmon Creek

from Bodega Bay go north on Hwy 1 to South Salmon Creek turnoff. Park in free lot, don't park on narrow street. Ocean, creek, dunes, summer cottages, restroom. Critique in parking lot.

December 10

PAINT OUT & Holiday POTLUCK

at the home of Lorraine & Don Levias, 780 W School St., Cotati. Country views include: barns, farm animals, ranch land. Park on either side of driveway, NOT on street. Directions: coming from north on 101, exit Gravenstein Hwy/CA 116, turn right. Left on W Cotati Ave, slight right onto Maple Ave, slight right onto W School St, PARK on either side of driveway, NOT on street.

December 17

Old Penngrove

Let's try this one again. (low turnout hot August). Located between Petaluma and Cotati with interesting buildings and views.

December 24

Healdsburg Plaza

Shops, fountains, railroad/sculpture one block west. Critique in plaza square.

January 7

Town of Bodega

Hwy. 12 Vintage movie site buildings, ranch views. Will be contacting Casino for former deal of park here if you buy lunch here.

January 14

Jack London State Park

The historic park is at 2400 London Ranch Road in Glen Ellen, about 20 minutes north of Sonoma. Take Hwy 12 east to right turn on London Ranch Rd. Turn right into parking lot where critique will be-the park's upper parking lot provides access to a picnic area, London's cottage, stables, stone barns, silos and "pig palace." State park fee: \$6

January 21

Spring Lake Regional Park

Santa Rosa from 101: Hwy 12 exit east, continue east on Hoen Avenue, cross Summerfield Road, left at stop sign (Newanga Avenue) into park, \$6 fee at entrance, right to parking lot above lake/critique spot near restrooms.

January 28

Helen Putnam Regional Park

411 Chileno Valley Rd, off Western Ave west of Petaluma, 216 acres, \$5 parking.
